## Itinerary on a day to day Basis

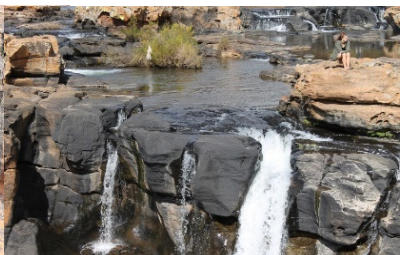
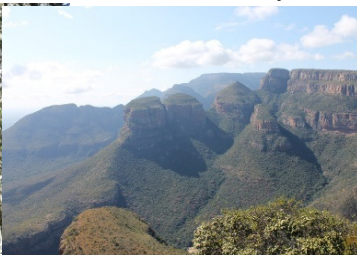
Day 1                      Graskop  
Accommodation:            Hotel

Today you will travel by road to the town of Graskop, which is the start of the Panorama Route. Here you will get the chance to visit the numerous stalls, offering african craft and other local goods. A visit to the silk factory is a must for the ladies seeking to be spoilt.



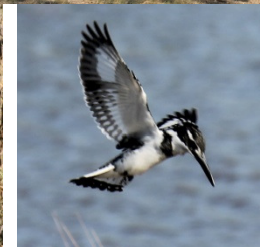
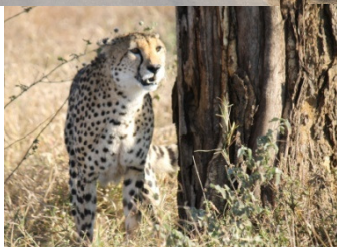
Day 2                      Panorama Route

Here you will visit the famous 3 Rondawels, Bourkes Pot Holes and the incredible view of God's Window, where you will have a chance to walk into a fairy forest on top of the mountain.



Day 3                      Kruger Park

This is one of the largest animal wildlife parks in the world extending about 350Km X 240km in size. It has a varied ecology which allows for the diversity to be seen in the park.

You will visit the Candle Factory and also the Glass blowing factory depending on time availability.



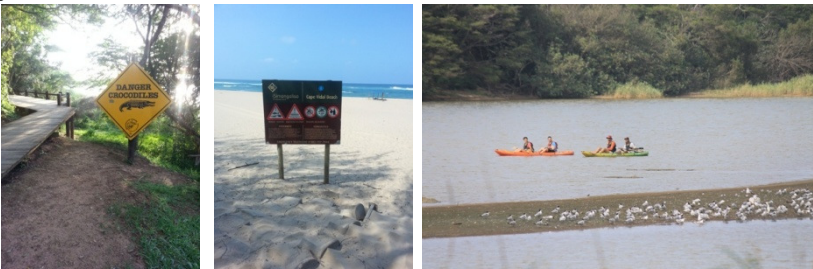
Day 7 St Lucia Estuary

Day 12 Visit to Knysna Lagoon and tsitsikama National Park

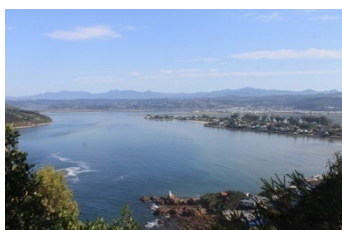
Accommodation:

 You will stop in Hout Bay where you will embark on a boat trip to go and see a seal colony, then you will travel via Chapman's Peak with one of the most spectacular views in the country, and you will then enter Cape point Nature reserve where you will visit the Light House and will enjoy a 360 degree view of the Peninsula and False Bay.  
 You will then Visit the famous Cape Of Good Hope and then you will begin your return via Simon's Town where you will visit Boulders Penguin Colony.  
 Passing Simon's Town , you will be taken back in time with the very old architecture.
